



#### The 2 clubs Landy

This convention is an overcall by the player in second seat after a 1NT opening. It's a very efficient and economic way of announcing a major two-suiter.

- a major two-suiter at least 5-4
- and in general a minimum of ten or so HCP. You can have fewer points if the two suits are 5-5 and you are non-vulnerable...



Problem E1504 2 ♣ Landy to announce your major two-suiter.



#### Problème E1483

3 - Be careful! 2 clubs would be a Landy promising a major two-suiter....





#### The bidding after a 2 clubs Landy:

The Landy can be used immediately in second seat, but also as a re-opening bid in fourth seat. How many points do you need?

- It depends if you are vulnerable or not
- and also how strong the two suits are. It will sometimes be possible to overcall in second seat with only 7HCP but the suits must be 5-5 and have good intermediate cards.
- If re-opening in fourth seat you could have even less, but in that case you know your Partner has points!



Exercise E5609 2 • a minimum Landy with two suits 5-5 and 5HCP. (Of course all the points are in those two suits!)



Exercise 5734 A Landy re-opening bid with only 5HCP but with a great unbalanced hand and the knowledge that your Partner is strong!





### **Bidding after 2 clubs Landy:**

- 2 diamonds shows a weak hand and asks the Partner to choose his best major
- 2 hearts or 2 spades shows a weak hand and a preference for that suit
- 3 hearts or 3 spades proposes game in that suit
- 4 hearts or 4 spades for game.



Exercise E5418 2 ♦ With no real preference for a major, leave it up to the overcaller to announce his five-card suit.




Exercise E5420 3 • With ten or so HCP and a four-card major, propose game.





## **Examples of responses to a Landy:**



Exercise E5421 4 spades.Go to game with this strong hand.



Exercise E5419 2 spades. With this weak hand, respond at the lowest level!
