## Blackwood for the Kings

The Blackwood for the Kings is bid at 5 NT When the side has all key cards and the Queen of trump They are different options for responding (make sure your pair is clear on which one it uses:

- By level
- $6 \boldsymbol{2}=0$ King
- 6 * $=1$ King
- $6 \vee=2$ Kings
- 30/41
- Naming the suit of the King economically : With 2 Kings you bid the grand slam

Make sure you agree with your partner. Kit recommends bidding the suit of your first King..
