



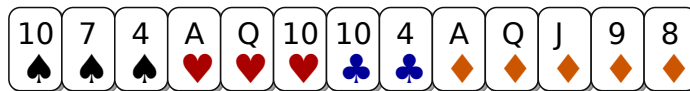
## Opener's 1NT rebid

### Opener's NT rebid.

A 1NT bid always shows a regular and non forcing hand  
The level depends on the strength of the hand :

- With a regular and 1st zone hand (12-14HCP) : 1NT
- With a 2nd zone hand (15-17HCP) : 2NT no jump bid . This only happens after an opening in a major; without a 5 card major, you would have opened 1NT
- With a 3rd zone hand (18-19HCP) : 2NT with a jump bid

Problem E1201 Rebid 1NT with a regular and 1st zone hand.

1 ♠	Pass	2 ♥	Pass
2 NT			



Problem E1628 With a 2nd zone hand, no fit and no other suit biddable, suggest going for a NT Game.



## Opener's 1NT rebid

### Opener's 1NT rebid

Showing a regular and 1st zone hand, therefore denying a two-suiter

Examples :

Problem E1201 5332 distribution with a 5 card minor is a regular hand. If the Responder has been informed about your hand .. he is able to establish the best contract for your team

Problem E1210 Denies 4 ♥ and 4 ♠, shows a regular and 1st zone hand.



## Opener's 1NT rebid

### Opener's 2NT without a jump rebid

S	W	N	E

Problem E1644 To bid a regular and 2nd zone hand which wasn't able to be opened by a 1NT bid because of a 5 card major



## Opener's 1NT rebid

### Opener's 2NT with a jump rebid

S	W	N	E
1 ♦	Pass	1 ♥	Pass
2 NT			



Problem E1198 The rebid of 2NT with a jump requires :

- a regular hand
- a 3rd zone hand

Denies a 5 card major biddable at the 1 level.
