



### The dealer's overcalls after an initial pass and two adverse bids.

You need an interesting hand of 8-10HCP with the high cards concentrated in the two other suits. The main overcalls are:

- Double, which guarantees 8HCP and 4 cards in the other two suits.
- 1NT which promises a two-suiter in the other two suits.
- Cue bid of the minor opening promises a two-suiter 5-5 in the other two suits.



#### Problème e3801

An example of the overcall situation of the dealer after an initial pass.





### The double

This is a takeout double calling for the other two suits. It guarantees:

At least 8HCP and 4 cards in the other two suits.

You started by passing so your Partner knows that your double isn't as strong as it would have been in the first round.



#### Problème e3800

With 8HCP and 4 cards in the other two suits, action is needed!





### 1NT after an initial pass.

This bid is conventional and shows a two-suiter in the other two suits. If these are the major suits, it's because there were four spades which prevented a weak two opening. The two-suiter is therefore 6-4 with the six-card suit being always the lowest ranked. If these are the minor suits, the two-suiter could be 6-4, 5-4 or 5-5 in a hand too weak for the cue bid.



#### Problème e3804

1NT is conventional and shows a two-suiter 6-4 in the other two suits.





## The cue bid of the opening suit after an initial pass.

This bid is conventional and shows a two-suiter 5-5 in the other two suits.



### Problème e5339

2 diamonds. The cue bid of the opening after an initial pass shows a two-suiter 5-5 in the other two suits.
