



# Bids after Opener's 2NT rebid

# font size='20px'> After a minor suit opening, Opener's response jump bid to 2NT

- guarantees a 3rd zone hand (18-19HCP)
- denies a biddable major at the 1 level

Responder immediately knows whether to look for Game or Slam. 2NT is strong but non forcing. : Responder passes with 4-5HCP



Problem E1198 No biddable major at the 1 level, regular hand and 18-19HCP (18HCP in this case), Opener rebids 2NT.






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
#### Responder's 2nd bid after Opener's jump bid to 2NT

All Responder's shift bids are forcing except Game sign off :

- With the strength for Game and a 5 card major, the Responder bids his other minor (type of Roudi)
- Support bid in opening minor is natural
- Rebidding the major at the 3 level shows 6 cards and Slam hopes.
- On the other hand, if Responder rebids his minor at the 3 level, this means minimum support.



Problem E5148 3♣ Game forcing and 5♥ cards (type of Roudi)



Problem E5149 Rebidding the major at the 3 level shows 6 cards and Slam hopes.

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




# Bids after Opener's 2NT rebid

Further biding after Opener's 2NT rebid. Responder's 2nd bid



Problem E6227 Jump bid to 4♥ is a sign off bid with 6COs and no slam hope.



Problem E9258 3 - support bid and Game forcing.

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
