



Bids after Opener's 2NT rebid

font size='20px'> After a minor suit opening, Opener's response jump bid to 2NT

- guarantees a 3rd zone hand (18-19HCP)
- denies a biddable major at the 1 level

Responder immediately knows whether to look for Game or Slam. 2NT is strong but non forcing. : Responder passes with 4-5HCP



Problem E1198 No biddable major at the 1 level, regular hand and 18-19HCP (18HCP in this case), Opener rebids 2NT.






Bids after Opener's 2NT rebid

Responder's 2nd bid after Opener's jump bid to 2NT

All Responder's shift bids are forcing except Game sign off :

- With the strength for Game and a 5 card major, the Responder bids his other minor (type of Roudi)
- Support bid in opening minor is natural
- Rebidding the major at the 3 level shows 6 cards and Slam hopes.
- On the other hand, if Responder rebids his minor at the 3 level, this means minimum support.



Problem E5148 3♣ Game forcing and 5♥ cards (type of Roudi)



Problem E5149 Rebidding the major at the 3 level shows 6 cards and Slam hopes.

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




Bids after Opener's 2NT rebid
