



## Responding to a opening 3NT Gambling

### With this pre-empt bid of 3NT, your Partner promises

Your responding aid minor suit with 7 established tricks

- approx 10HCP
- Pass with stoppers in the other suits.
  no outside (in any other suit) honors
- 4 to limit the damage
- 4 ♦ looking for Slam
- 4NT asking your P to bid his minor
- 5♣ to play Game in your Partner's suit.



Problem E4483 PASS. At first glance you have 9 tricks. You would be really unlucky on a ♠ lead. You'd go down one.





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#### bids are conventional

- 4♣: this means sign off: Opener passes if his minor is ♣, if not he rectifies to 4♦.
- 5♣: to play Game: Opener passes if his minor is ♣, if not he rectifies to 5♦.



Problem E4486 Strategic fall-back!



Problem E4487 Your P will bring 7 leading ♣ tricks. You have 4 tricks. So together you have 11. But only on the condition that ♣ is trumps.





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### Slam attempt with 4 ◆ et follow up bids

Sur cette enchère de 4 ♦ l'ouvreur de 3 SA gambling annonce :

- 4 ♥ with a ♥ singleton
- 4 ♠ with a ♠ singleton
- 4 SA with no singleton
- 5♣ with a ♦ singleton
- 5 ♦ with a ♣ singleton

The responder then decides on final contract.
