



## Rebid by the opener of 1NT

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The rebid depends of course on the partner's response. The principal responses are :

- 2 clubs Stayman
- Texas
- 3 NT
- Pre-empt
- slam bids

Problem 1858

2 hearts After the responder's 2 club Stayman, the opener calls his 4-card major

Problem 1219

Pass With a minimum 1NT opening, the opener refuses the slam proposal



## Rebid by the opener of 1NT

### The opener's rebid after the responder's Stayman

After the responder's 2 clubs, the opener gives the number of his 4-card majors: 0, 1 or 2.

- Without a 4-card major : 2 ♦
- With one major : 2 in that suit, either 2 hearts or 2 spades.
- With both 4-card majors : 2 ♥

Problem 4825 2 ♦ without a 4-card major to call



## Rebid by the opener of 1NT

### The opener's rebid ....

- After the responder's Texas: the opener rectifies the Texas
- 3NT: the responder knows slam is impossible and that it's best to play NT. The opener must pass.
- Pre-empt bid of 4 hearts or 4 spades: the responder knows slam is impossible and this is the best contract. The opener must pass.

#### Problème 1216

The Texas must be rectified regardless of the strength or number of cards in that suit.



## Rebid by the opener of 1NT

### After the responder's slam bid

- A 4NT response proposes slam and the opener will accept if he's maximum.
- 3 hearts or 3 spades by the responder means an excellent 6-card suit and the strength to think about slam: the opener either starts the controls or refuses the proposal.
