The fourth seat reopening bid after a preempt opening

After a preempt opening followed by two passes, you can reopen by:

- bidding a six-card suit or a very strong five-card suit with a dozen or so good points;
- doubling as from 11-12HCP and a suitable distribution. The double calls for the majors as a priority...
- bidding NT with strength in the opponents' suit or an independent minor.
- bidding 4NT with a minor two-suiter.

Fourth seat reopening NT bid

- 3NT with the intention of playing them! You need to be able to stop the opening suit and have at least 7 sure tricks.
- 4NT with jump. This jump overcall always shows a minor two-suiter at least 5-5.
