



further bidding after a Stayman : after 2 CA

The responder's 2nd bid with a 5-4 in the majors, after a 2♦ rebid by the opener

With less than 10HCP, the responder bids :

- 2♥ with 5 cards in ♥
- 2♠ with 5 cards in ♠

The opener will bid game if he is maximum

With 10+HCP the responder uses the Criss Cross :

- 3♥ with 5 cards in ♠ and 4 in ♥
- 3♠ with 5 cards in ♥ and 4 in ♠

The opener rectifies to 4♠ or 4♥ and will be the declarer
