The reponder's 2 nd bid with a 5-4 in the majors, after a $2 \checkmark$ rebid by the opener

With less than 10 HCP , the responder bids:

- $2 \sqrt{\text { vith }} 5$ cards in $\downarrow$
- 2 a with 5 cards in $\uparrow$

The opener will bid game if he is maximum

With $10+\mathrm{HCP}$ the reponder uses the Criss Cross :

- $3 \vee$ with 5 cards in $\uparrow$ and 4 in $\downarrow$
- $3 \boldsymbol{\sim}$ with 5 cards in $\downarrow$ and 4 in $\uparrow$

The opener rectifies to $4 \wedge$ or $4 \vee$ and will be the declarer


Problem E8036 5 cards in $\uparrow$ and 8 HCP ; the responder bids his 5 cards major. With a minimum opening, the opener will pass.


Problem E6004 After the $2 \star$ rebid by the opener, $3 \uparrow$ is a transfer for $\downarrow$ (with 5 cards in $\downarrow$ and at least 10HCP). The opener will rectify and will be the declarer.

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
