



The Opener fits the Responder's major

The Opener has a fit in the Responder's major:

- With a first-zone hand (12-14HCP)raise to 2 level.
- With a second-zone hand, give a double raise to 3 level. This is a non-forcing game proposal.
- With a third-zone hand, raise to 4 level in the major or make a slam bid according to the strength of the hand.



ProblemE1197The Responder's single raise indicates a heart fit of 4 cards and an ordinary first-zone opening (12-14HCP)



Problem E1204Double raise to show a 4 card fit and a second-zone hand.


