Multi 2 + : opening and responses

Multi 2 • is offering some benefits during the bidding :

- Most of the time, the contract is played by the strong hand , protecting tenaces and making the defenders' job more difficult.
- it leaves space for 2 ♥ or 2 ♠
- It is possible to look for a game but stop at level 3
- it makes the defense difficult.. the opponents don't know what the opener's suit is!

3 types of hands for a multi 2 \blacklozenge :

- Weak 2 major openings
- Super 2 NT with 22-23 HCP
- strong minor one suiters

Dominique recommends to use it with weak 2 major opening hands !



Exercise E9475 According to the multi 2 < convention, open 2 <... a hand for which you would have opened a major weak 2







Responding to a multi 2 🔶

In the simple version, it is not forcing...without any hope for a game nor a fit, but with a good \blacklozenge length, you may pass !

2 \heartsuit or 2 \bigstar are ambiguous responses, 2 NT is forcing. The responder starts bidding his worst major suit, the opener changes or passes

- 2 ♥ response It's the weakest response : the responder wishes to stop there if the opener holds a weak 2 ♥ opening hand. Technically, every time the responder has no fit in any of the major suits, he will bid 2 ♥.
- 2 ▲ response Stop there if the opener holds a weak 2 ▲ opening hand....but the responder is ok for a 3 ♥ contract if the opener has the ♥.
- 2 NT response relay, forcing for one round without any game ambition (it is similar to the response to a major weak 2 opening). To think of a game, you need a minimum of 15 (or 13-14 HCP well constructed).



Exercise 9516 2 ♠ With a weak hand, start bidding your shortest major suit. Your partner will pass or change for 3 ♥.



Exercise E9517 You hold a strong hand : start with the positive 2 NT. The opener will give more information on the next round.


Opener's rebid after a 2 NT response :

- 3 ♣ : the opener has a weak 2 ♥ hand
- 3 ♦ : the opener has a weak 2 ♠ hand
- 3♥: the opener has a weak 2 ♠ hand, but on the high range
- 3 ♠ : the opener has a weak 2 ♥ hand, but on the high range/li>

Whatever the response, the partner has the information, and he will conclude.



Exercise E9484 The opener bids 3 ♣ to show his minimum weak 2 ♥ opening hand.



Exercise E9486 The opener bids 3 ♥ to show a maximum weak 2 ♠ opening hand (10H).
