- 2 NT
- Repeating his opening minor
- Support in the responder's major at the 3



- rebidding second suit to show a 6 5 two suiter forcing
- Bidding 4th suit to impose game
- Jump rebid of first suit , forcing
- Splinter, 4 NT...
