



Leading against a doubled 3NT contract

Leading against a NT contract : Your Partner has doubled.

Opps have bid one or more suits.,

- if Opps have bid a suit, your P is asking for a lead in the suit bid by dummy.
- if Opps have bid several suits, your P is asking for a lead in the 1st suit bid by dummy.
