

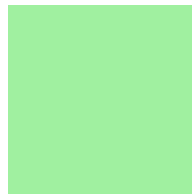


## After a bidding sequence 1X-1SA-2Y

**Specific leads : after a minimum two-suiter bid and a response bid of 1NT. Responder has bid 1NT, then has passed on the Opener's 2nd suit bid.**

If Responder has passed on the 2nd round of bidding after having bid 1NT, then choose the killer lead : trumps! All the champions do this. The reason? Dummy is weak and short in the 1st suit bid. This is to stop Declarer from ruffing so often.
