




Defence in 2nd seat after dummy

The card to play by the defence : dummy is doubleton

In 2nd position if dummy has only 2 cards, then this rule shouldn't be used blindly. If you have an honor 3rd (K/Q or J) it's in your interest to play it even on a high card in dummy



Follow the rule : When dummy has a doubleton, if you are seated just after and Declarer plays an honor from dummy then cover. The Declarer will only make 2 tricks.





Defence in 2nd seat after dummy

Continuing the above example.
