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Responder's NT bid is asking for information : Opener must then bid his strength and/or distribution.

With a minimum opening Opener rebids his suit at the 3 level

With a maximum opening (8-9HCP) : Opener bids :

- an outside honor at the 3 level
- a singleton/chicane at the 4 level
- with a strong hand, no singleton and no outside honor : 3NT
- If you have a singleton and an outside honor, give priority to bidding your outside honor.

- Only bid your hand at the 3 level if you have a maximum 8-9HCP and possibly with an exceptional 10HCP.
- Only bid the 2 highest honors : Ace and King
- If you have a singleton and an outside honor, give priority to bidding your outside honor.
