## Take out double in fourth position

## Take out double in fourth seat.

- If only one suit has been bidden, the double promises 4 cards in the unannounced suits in a slightly stronger hand than if you were in second seat.
- If two suits have been bidden? Double shows a two-suiter 4-4 in the remaining suits


Problem E3223 Only 12HCP but all well placed in the other three suits. Appreciate your two tens and even the three eights. Not all the side cards are useless!


Problem E3224 PASS in spite of the 13HCP for two main reasons: you don't have four spades and the queen of hearts is not worth much.

Problem E3796 Appeals against $\boldsymbol{\bullet} \boldsymbol{\sim}$, the remaining 2 couleurs. In this sequence, with $4 \vee$ and $4 \boldsymbol{\wedge}, 10-11 \mathrm{HCP}$ are enough to Double. The important thing is that the honors are well grouped in two majors.


Problem E9359 You're hand is too strong to directly bid PIYour hand is worth 18 HCP :a beautiful 6-suiter, 3 aces, well placed after the Responder .... You can bid your $\uparrow$ in the next round.
