



## After an opening of e 1 ♣ or 1 ♦, the responder jumps in the other minor

This convention is now widely used and Kit recommends you should use it.

After, a minor opening and the opps have passed, with :

- 5 or 6 cards in the opening minor
- 8 to 11HCPs
- No 4 cards major
- bid a jump in the other minor

This support is more constructive than a preempt in the opening minor.

Careful ! to use it, you must have passed first.
