### Response to a trial bid

After having supported your partner (the opener), you now have to respond to is trial bid. The opener has chosen to rebid a new suit, therefore he is showing :

- an unbalanced hand
- a need for help in the named suit (most of the time, he has 4 or 5 cards)

Exercise 20251 4♥ Go to game ! Your ♣ singleton will bring a great help (ruff) and your two honors are very interesting !




