



## Slam bid : 5CO or 5PI

## 5♥ or 5♠ bid slam proposal. After the opponents' overcall

When one of the opponents has overcalled, a jump to level 5 in the major is a slam proposal. It's asking for a stopper in the opponent's suit.

Partner's response :

- With 2 low cards in the opponent's suit : Pass
- With a 2nd rank control (singleton or K) : 6 in the agreed major
- With a 1st rank control (void or Ace) : the partner names the II nomme la couleur adverse (5 ♠ ou 5 ♥) : the partner will then decide to go to small or grand slam



Problem 20271 5♥ : asking the partner if he's got a ♠ stopper !



Exercise E7293 6♥. Agree with your partner's proposal. You have a stopper in the opponent's suit. But don't go for a grand slam with your 2 low ♠ cards. A small slam will be good enough !

## Slam bid : 5CO or 5PI

A level 5 jump raise is a small slam proposal. You go for it when you have 2 high honors in the trump suit. Else, just Pass !
