You've opened the bidding with 1 in a suit, your partner has passed and your RHO has produce a wake up bid.

On the second round, only bid if you have something interesting to say to your partner For example :

- you have a very strong hand
- or an unusual distribution (Two suiter on very long suit..)

If not: Pass !

Problem E20313 With this beautiful hand, a take-out double offers more options than just bidding 2 ♥. It could also help you find a fit in ♣....

the different possible bids for opener:

- The repetition of his opening suit shws a nice 6 card suit
- with a strong hand and a shortness in hte opps' suit use the take-out double !
- With 18-19HCP, a regular hand and a good stopper in the opps' suit : 1 NT (and not 2NT with a jump!)
- Redouble show a strong hand (3rd zone) and numerous defensive tricks

Problem E20314 unforced repetition of opening suit that guarantees a solid 6 cards suit : a jump to 3 ♠ would be exaggerated, las your partner's hand could be very weak !
