



The Economical Two suiter and the Jump two suiter

The choice between Economical/ Jump Two suiter bid

- The two suiter nid is 'economical', When the second suit bid is lower than the repetition of the first.
- The jump two suiter: The opener bids his second suit at a level above the lowest level at which it could have been bid (.. jumping a level).
- The economical two suiter bid is not forcing: could very well pass after you've bid your second suit.
- The 'Jump' two-suiter is forcing to game : neither you nor your partner can pass until game has been reached.

2 • Bid your second suit at the lowest level possible . Your hand is not strong enough to impose game



Exercice E20386

3 ◆ Jump shift to bid your second suit : your 20HD hand is strong enough to impose game even if your partner is minimum (6HCP).
