### The 'scrambling' 2NT convention after a strong 2 suiter by opener ( forcing for one round)

The responder will use the 2NT convention with 5-7HCP (or with a slam hand). this bid warns the opener that the camp may not have the values to bid game .

#### Problème 20364

There is a fit in ♣....but showing support to opener would make the sequence forcing to game..when game is far from certain if opener is minimum.

Bid 2 NT to Slow Down the ambitions of opener This bid is forcing for one round and your next bid will be pass.



## The 'scrambling' 2NT after strong two suiter bid by opener

### Bids following The 'scrambling' 2NT bid (after opener has shown a strong two suiter ( forcing pour un tour)

- If opener repeats his first suit, The responder can pass or support his second suit. It will enable to stop before game if necessary !
- With a maximum hand, The opener can impose game
