



After a wake-up bid

Follow up bids after a wake-up bid at level 1

- After a bid in a suit
 - * Suits shifts are forcing and show :
 - 4 cards and 8HD at the 1 level
 - 5 cards and 12HD at higher levels
 - *NT bids
 - 1 NT with 8-12HD
 - 2 NT with a jump 13-14HD
 - * support bids :
 - simple : 8-12HD
 - Jump support : with irregular hands
 - * Cue-bid
 - At least 13HD and a fit in the wake-up suit
 - or at least 13HD without a better bid
 - After a take-out double, the "doubler" owes his partner a bid, if he had a decent overcalling hand (12-13HCP).
