




Help suit game tries

Help suit game tries (HSGT)

A Help suit game try may occur after a 2 level support in the opener's Major, when the opener holds game invitational values but has a weakness in a side suit

It asks responder to bid game if he has values in that suit.


responder should bid game with a first or second round control. With 2 - 2.5 losers, responder will use his judgement. And with 3+ losers he should just sign off at 3 in the agreed major

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Help suit game tries


Help suit game tries (HSGT)... if you also play Short Suit Game Tries (SSGT)


If opener, after a 1♥ initial bid and a 2 level support then bids 2NT

The opener (iF your pair also plays Short Suit Game Try) bids Then bids 2NT that means he could not bid $2 \spadesuit$ (as it would have been the start of SSGT).. and that he is asking for help in \spadesuit .

responder should bid 3♠ with a first or second round controlin ♠. With 2 - 2.5 losers, responder will use his judgement. And with 3+ losers he should just sign off at 3♥







Opener has the values for a game invite but is afraid of the \spadesuit losers. Also playing SSGT he cannot bid $2 \spadesuit$ which would show a shortness so he bids 2NT 'generalized' HSGT in TRResponder with Values and the Ace \spadesuit , bids $3 \spadesuit$ after which opener can conclude at $4 \heartsuit$
