



## Taking over as captain

In certain sequences, preempt opening, search for a slam, or simply looking for the best part-score, the role of each player is clearly differentiated. One is collecting information from his partner and the other one decides !

Exercise 4855 The responder precisely describes his 11-12HD hand with 4 cards in ♠. The opener becomes the captain in the selection of the final contract.

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Exercise 4857 The opener describes his 15-17HCP haand not 4 cards in ♥. The responder, with slam interest becomes the captain

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## Taking over as captain

The player that bids a Blackwood takes over as captain for the sequence

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Exercise 4859 The opener gives his partner the opportunity to take over as captain by naming the last control. His partner accepts by bidding a Blackwood or refuses by returning to 4♠.

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Exercise 4860 The opener takes over as captain by bidding a Blackwood

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## Taking over as captain

A player that forced his partner to bid a control is the captain for the sequence.

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Exercise 4861 The ambitions of the opener that bid his first control are clear...His partner can't escape this.

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Exercise 4862 The ambitions of the opener that bid his first control are clear...His partner can't escape this..  
Now South must bid his first control.

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
