



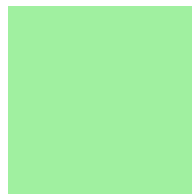
Forcing NT - Opener's 2nd bids

Forcing NT

In 2/1: a 1NT response to a 1♥ or 1♠ opening, shows 6 to 12 HCP, no fit in the opener's suit (... and not 4 cards in ♠, if opener has opened 1♥) .. And is forcing for one round

Forcing 1NT does not apply
after a 1♣ or 1♦ opening bid.
if responder is a passed hand
if responder's RHO overcalls or makes a take-out Double

Partner opens 1♥. Here you bid 2♣. With two 4-card suits respond up-the-line. This is the same principle used in standard bidding.

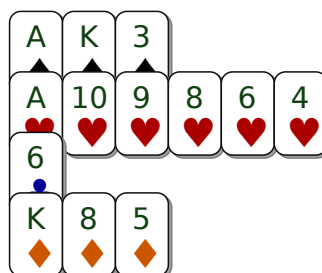
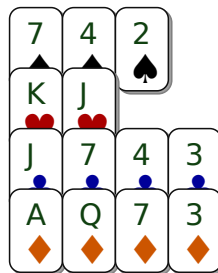


Forcing NT - Opener's 2nd bids

Opener's rebids after a Forcing NT: after a 1♥ initial bid

- 2♣ shows a 2+ clubs... may be 4522 with insufficient values for an inverted two-suiter...
- 2♦ shows 3+ ♦....may be 4531 with insufficient values for an inverted two-suiter... or 3532
- 2♥ Shows a 6 carder, and may have a 4 cards side suit
- 2♠ is an inverted 2-suiter with 4+ spades and 16+HCP.
- 2NT shows a balanced hand with 18-19HCP. It is an invite for 3NT
- All other bids are natural... or could be conventional, subject to a partnership agreement

Problem E40101

After 1NT forcing, the 2♥ rebid by opener. Natural, 11-15 points and at least six Hearts The 3♥ rebid by responder Inviting game with a (nice) doubleton is an invite (.. now that he knows there is a fit)

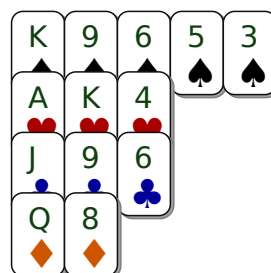
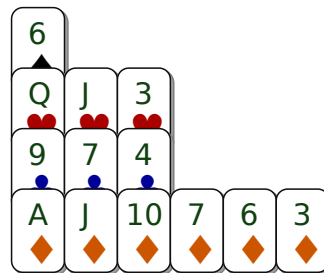
2♥ Shows 4+ ♥, with 11-15HCP (Insufficient values for a jump shift..)

2♠ is an inverted 2-suiter with 4+ spades and 16+HCP.

2NT shows a balanced hand with 18-19HCP. It is an invite for 3NT

All other bids are natural... or could be conventional, subject to a partnership agreement

E 40103 Opener is stuck for his 2nd bid. Must bid 2♣ which shows at least three clubs. (E.g. 5-3-2-3 shape.) Responder then mentions his 5 carder 2♦, showing least a five card suit, 6-10 points, non-forcing
