




Automatic or positional Squeeze

• If both threats are in the same hand, the squeeze is 'positional' . It can only work against the opp 9 sitioned before the threats..




Exercise 25562 You play the squeezing card' 10 ◆ and discard the 9 ♥ from the dummy (free card): East is stuck, if he discards the ♥, South's 5 is set. This squeeze also works if you swap East's and West's hands, It is an automatic squeeze.





Example with East's and West's hands swapped



Exercise Q25569 You play the squeezer (10 \blacklozenge) If West discards the 10 \blacktriangledown you discard the 10 \clubsuit from the dummy: vous faites ensuite 2 \clubsuit et 1 \blacktriangledown . . If West discards a small \clubsuit , you discard the 9 \blacktriangledown and your $\gt \clubsuit$ are established. This squeeze also works if you swap East's and West's hands, It is an automatic squeeze.





The squeeze is 'automatic' if it also works if you swap East's and West's hands. In that case, it is required to have an entry into North's hand. In uour example, South must keep a small * to be able to get to dummy if West decides to discard a * on the 'squeezer'





The squeeze is positional when both threats are in the same hand. It is then necessary that the opp that has the guards' in the 2 suits of the squeeze, be placed before the threats... otherwise, you'd be the one that is squeezed.....
