



Wake-up bids with a two-suiter

Wake up bids with a two-suiter are not always the same as overcalls...

- After a minor opening, a cue-bid shows a major two-suiter, at least 5-5 and a maximum of 7 losers
- After a major opening, a cue-bid shows a two-suiter with the other major and an undefined minor, at least 5-5 and a maximum of 6 losers.
- Careful: a 2 NT wake up bid is not a minor two-suiter but a wake up bid with 17-19 HCP and a balanced hand: In a wake up bid, you cannot show a two-suiter with the two weakest suits.
