



With a fit in the opener's major, the responder's bids are hardly affected by the second seat overcaller.

- PASS with less than 4-5HCP.
- Support bids:

  o at the low
  o propose g
  o go to gam

  S W N E

  and more than 4-5HCP
  four trumps and 8-9HCP
  11HCP
- Make a forcing jump shift with 11HCP or more and a five-card suit
- Cue bid th Q J 7 8 5 4 10 8 3 2 J 7 5 m proposal)

#### Problème E4888

PASS with 4 totally ineffective HCP.

2 heartsA weak support





# Supporting bids

In a competitive auction and with a hand limited to 10-11HCP, you must give immediate support at the right level.

Give polite support at the lowest level with at least 4-5HCP

Propose game at three level with four trumps and more than 8-9HCP

Go to game with four trumps and 10-11HCP.

3 hearts Game proposal with 9 strong HCP



### Problème E4891

4 hearts Game support with 11 strong HCP





## The other bids

Jump shifts at the two level are forcing. They promise:11HCP or more and at least five cards in the new suit.



### Problème E1254

2 hearts With at least 11HCP and a five-card suit, jump shift at the two level.





# Cue bidding the overcall

### Be careful!

All direct supporting bids are limited to 10-11HCP maximum. With more than that, cue bid the overcall to show strength and to look for slam.



### Problème E4893

3 clubs Begin with a cue bid to show your strength (and often a fit, although not necessarily)
